

# The NWM Unmaintained Ride



Join a 2-day ride on the challenging No Winter Maintenance route. Riders can test out their early season bikepacking skills, learn from seasoned veterans and meet new cycling friends. It's also a good training ground for a more ambitious bikepacking adventure such as the BT 700.

Date: June 4 – June 5

Start/Finish: Orangeville, Ontario (There is a public parking lot that allows for overnight parking)

Overnight: Group camping will be provided by Bowering Lodge ([www.boweringlodge.com](http://www.boweringlodge.com)) which is close to the halfway mark of the route. The fee for camping is still to be determined. Riders can also choose to book one of their indoor rooms. This option is best done well in advance. Rider numbers will be limited based on capacity limits for the camping.

The Rally Beer Company ([drinkrally.ca](http://drinkrally.ca)) will be present at the overnight camping spot letting riders sample their excellent beverages.
